Further information and guides will be released in the coming weeks outlining the available options.

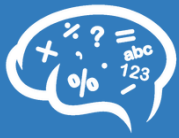

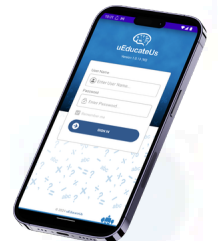

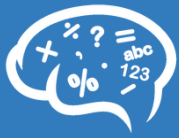
Incidents: New staff access Level 3

Over the holidays, a new Staff Access management level was added to the Incidents module, allowing for the use of *Level 3* for non-administrator users to access to level 3 incidents.

The new access level: *Level 3 [Full Access]* has been introduced for managing the incidents module including managing staff access. By default, all school principals have access to this level and can grant to other administrators where appropriate.

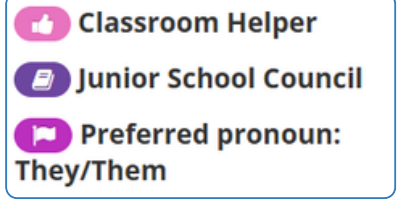

uEducateUs eduHub connector v2.1.0

Further to our update last year, we are working towards migrating all of our uEducateUs government schools to the eduHub v2 endpoint.

We will be in contact with each school in coming weeks to obtain authorisation if you have not already done so. This change will also include an update to how uEducateUs exports your attendance data. Once migration has been complete, the uEducateUs eduHub connector will no longer be required.

System Security Updates



To meet the ongoing Department security requirements under the Safer Technologies 4 Schools (ST4S) standard, the following changes will be introduced during Term 1:

Longer Passwords

All passwords (both system-generated and user-created) will now need to be at least 14 characters long.

Easier System Passwords

System-generated passwords will be updated to match the new length rules and will be designed to be easier to type and remember until you set your own.

Password Change on First Login

If your account is given a system-generated password, you will be asked to change it the next time you log in.
